This impactful course has a unique format where students will attend with a teacher-advisor (teacher fee is \$50.00 only, to cover meal costs). The focus will be school-based leadership development and increased student voice and engagement in student government, clubs/groups/teams, school community, advocacy, etc. Each school group will return with both individual and collective action plans.
