#### What to Expect from an OELC Leadership Course

OELC believes that our youth can and do make a difference – both today and tomorrow. We believe our role is to create a space that fosters curiosity, reflection and growth, and that provides youth with opportunities to learn about themselves, others and their communities. And we achieve this through leadership courses that are purposefully designed, highly engaging and full of FUN!

- Chewing gum (environmental/cleanliness reasons)
- Peanuts or any nut product (very important to check any snacks)
- Cell phones (at the core of our leadership programs is inclusion and interpersonal communication so the preference of our teaching staff is to leave this item behind)

#### **OELC Leadership Course Staff**

Each leadership course at OELC has its own dedicated and distinct staff comprised of a Course Director, Program Coordinators and Teacher and Youth Facilitators. Our staff are selected based on their passion, commitment and understanding of leadership, their educational expertise, and their belief in students' potential for personal growth, development and positive impact! Our student-to-staff ratio is a maximum of 15-20 to 1.

### **Student Accommodation**

Our student cabins are well-maintained and clean. Students must provide their own bedding or sleeping bag, pillow and towel.

## **Graffiti/Defacement of Property**

Is not permitted at OELC we have a strict no graffiti policy.

#### Food

No additional food needs to be packed for your visit. We have a no food in cabin policy for all campers as a resolution to the significant problems it causes. The attraction of bugs and animals in the cabin, allergy concerns, cabin cleanliness and hygiene issues and probably most significantly, the power struggles and negative feelings between those that have more versus those that have less.
