- The Ontario Educational Leadership Centre (OELC) prides itself on providing unique and exceptional leadership development programs to students from across Ontario. Each of our programs is staffed by teachers and professionals, all of whom are selected based on their educational and professional expertise, their understanding of, and commitment to leadership, and their belief in young people's personal growth and development.
- The Facilitator is an integral member of every program.
- Working in collaboration with the Program Director and Program Coordinators Facilitators undertake two key roles:

Facilitator

- Facilitators are responsible for facilitating workshops, sessions and activities that contribute to the leadership development experiences of young people.
While most leadership development sessions are created by the program team, facilitators are encouraged to use their own skills, experience, and passions to modify these sessions based on the needs of each particular group.

Additional Skills:

- Certain OELC programs require Facilitators to have additional skills,(e.g., special education, arts, athletics, recreation skills (see apply now) school leadership) Facilitators will draw on their respective areas of specialty to collaborate with the teams to develop innovative and dynamic leadership workshops that meet these specific needs.

Qualifications and Additional Responsibilities of Teacher Facilitators:

- Directly supervise and support the leadership development needs of a cabin of approximately 10 – 16 youth, including' physical and emotional well-being
- For elementary and intermediate programs, support Youth Facilitators in their leadership roles and development.
- Support the Program Director and Coordinators to implement the overall goals of the program and of OELC as a whole
- Support the program team in the overall operation of the program
- Flexibility and creativity in a changing environment
- ASSET: A member in good standing with the Ontario College of Teachers or another professionally regulated body
- Lodging and meals are provided for all program staff.
