

Youth Facilitator Role

As a Youth Facilitator you will be assigned to a cabin, as well as a section team consisting of two cabins.

- In partnership with your Teacher Facilitator, you will work with other cabin staff as a section team to plan and coordinate
- support the facilitation of leadership development sessions and other activities for a group
- of 20 to 30 students.

Youth Facilitator Qualifications:

- Must have completed Grade 10 (at a minimum)
- Must have completed one of OELC's leadership programs for Secondary students or demonstrate their experience in leading/facilitating groups in a program
- Demonstrate an enthusiasm to work with younger students in their development as leaders
- Demonstrate maturity and compassion
- Exceptional team work and communication skills

Responsibilities of Youth Facilitators:

- Create a positive, safe and supportive community for all leaders · Introduce leaders to the OELC philosophy, atmosphere
- Support Teacher Facilitators in their workshops, instructional periods and activities
- Participate and support the health and well-being of leaders in your cabin
- Assist and guide discussions during leadership development sessions
- Assist in coordinating special events for programs
- Lead evening reflections and ensure evening activities end on time
- Other duties as assigned by the program Director

Lodging and meals are provided plus an honourarium of \$250 PW
